**292<sup>nd</sup> board meeting of UPSIDC held**

In order to further strengthen U.P. State Industrial Development Corporation (UPSIDC), Chairman of UPSIDC, Shri Alok Ranjan has issued directions to put up a well-planned proposal for next 10 years pertaining to creation of sufficient land bank, infrastructure development and investment attraction. He asked to constitute a committee immediately for accelerated and organized infrastructure development of Trans-Ganga and Saraswati hi-tech cities. He instructed to advertise and to complete the selection process for allotment of residential plots in Saraswati hi-tech city in a transparent manner.

Chairman of UPSIDC was presiding over the 292<sup>nd</sup> board of directors' meeting of UPSIDC here today. To attract investment into the state, he said that a multi-media presentation depicting ambitious projects of UPSIDC should be prepared for publicity and it should also be uploaded on department's website along with playing it in investment conclaves and seminars. He asked to prepare a proposal for development of an integrated industrial city on Amritsar-Kolkata industrial corridor (AKIC) near Kanpur.



Shri Ranjan said that investors should be provided with all possible help and their issues should be resolved on priority to create an industry-friendly environment in Uttar Pradesh. He directed to upload updated information on land bank and schemes on the website of the corporation. He said that attractive schemes should be made to motivate the entrepreneurs to establish their units on the allotted plots. To achieve the physical and fiscal targets of financial year 2016-17, he said that works should be redefined with fixed milestones according to a time-schedule.

Meeting was attended by Managing Director of UPSIDC – Shri Amit Kumar Ghosh and Director, Shri Rishikesh Bhaskar Yashod along with other senior officials.
